The former palace of the archbishops of Reims was also the residence of the Kings of France during their coronation. The Palace of Tau houses the adjoining Cathedral Museum and the Coronation Museum. Sculptures, tapestries, costumes, ornaments and works of art in gold from the Middle Ages to the 19th century are a magnificent treasure.

MUSEUM OF THE SURRENDER. MAY 7, 1945

The unconditional surrender of the German army was signed in a room of General Eisenhower's headquarters on May 7, 1945. This room is still intact today and a museum has been created in 2005 in order to allow visitors to follow the major developments of World War II.






